

Students are eligible for ROOTS when they:

- are referred by their school.
- have successfully completed 2 years of high school.
- demonstrate a willingness to learn.
- are highly motivated to enter the workforce.
- are committed to take on new challenges everyday.

After 2 years of the ROOTS program students may be eligible for certification in their area of vocational interest.

Students may qualify for:

1. A Life and Work Skills Certificate
2. A Semi-specialized Certificate
3. An Apprenticeship
4. Entering the work force
5. Continuing their education in a vocational program or in an adult education program.

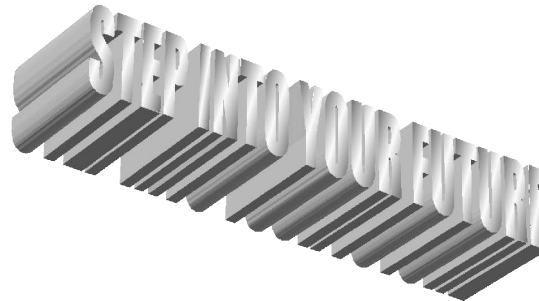
